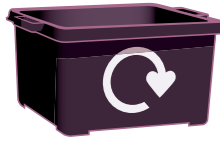

Refuse and recycling is collected fortnightly (Grey wheeled bin or beige refuse bag, black recycling box & blue cardboard sack). Food and garden waste (if subscribed) is collected weekly (kitchen caddy, green garden waste bin or garden waste paper sacks).
